Dear Parent/Carer

You may already be aware, that the DfE requires schools to continue to track and trace positive COVID-19 cases for a period of 6 days after the end of the Autumn term.

To enable us to manage this, if your child tests positive for COVID-19 between Friday 18th December and Thursday 24th December after having shown symptoms on either Saturday 19th December or Sunday 20th December (48 hours from being in school) then please let school know via text, or e-mail as soon as possible – we will then be able to put the necessary measures in place.

If your child develops symptoms more than 48 hours from last contact with students or staff at school, (From Mon 21st December onwards) you do not need to contact us. However, if your child will be absent due to illness or the need to self-isolate when we return to school on Wednesday 6th January 2021, you can let us know by phoning school on Monday 4th January 2021.

I hope that you all remain safe and well over the Christmas holiday and look forward to welcoming our children back to school on Wednesday 6th January 2021.
