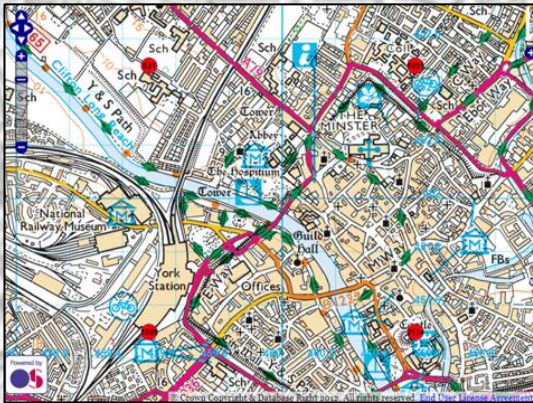
Landmark	A notable location with historical, cultural or geographical significance.

History of York

- The city was founded by the Romans in AD71.
- The Vikings developed it into the capital of Yorkshire.
- York minster started to be built in 627AD. It took over 250 years to be completed.
- Today, York has a population of 210,000 people.
- The rivers Foss and Ouse run through York.
- Many tourists visit York to see the minster, museums, castle and historic city walls.
- York also has a university and a football club.
