Dear families,

Following on from the announcement from the Prime minister on Sunday, schools have been issued with some updated guidance. This will mean a few small changes are needed, and we will be constantly monitoring and adapting to any new changes as they come. In summary the main changes for us will be:

Breakfast Club

All adults coming into Breakfast Club with their KS1 children, will now need to wear a mask at all times. If you are medically exempt from wearing one, we will need to see proof of this please.

Mask wearing

Whilst it is not mandatory, we would strongly advise all parents to wear a face mask whilst on the playground. We will do everything in our power to keep the school running as close to normal as possible, and appreciate that you will help us take every step we can to stop the spread of the virus. Staff will be wearing masks in communal areas and corridors.

Christmas Activities

We really would like to keep as many Christmas activities running as possible, however, we will assess every situation individually and keep you posted with any changes we need to make.

Holidays in term time

We are aware that lots of families have requested Leave of Absence during the coming few weeks, however, we would like to stress that countries are being added to the red list daily, and this could implicate your return to the UK. Last summer we were in a very difficult position where lots of families were unable to return to the UK, and faced the possibility of losing their place in school. We would strongly discourage any family going out of the country.

We need to ensure as a school we are doing everything in our power to stop the virus spreading.
