

Resources and Training for Special Educational Need



Staff Training:

At Coleridge, we make sure all our members of staff are provided with the correct trainings, so they can deliver effective teaching strategies to support individuals with needs. Each class has a TA to provide additional support for the pupils with SEN, disabilities or other additional needs.

Some training undergone by our staff are:

- Autism
- Dyslexia
- Dyspraxia
- Bonding through play
- PECS

Resources:

The SENCo has a yearly budget, which is spent effectively to buy equipment for the children with Special educational needs. It is spent on a wide range of equipment such as:

- Writing slopes
- Moving sit slope cushions
- Pencil grips
- Coloured overlays for reading
- Coloured paper books for both Maths and English (for dyslexic children)
- Sensory toys such as trampolines, peanut balls and sensory boards to support children regulate

We also have a sensory room, which is enjoyed by children who will go into crisis and need a place to regulate. This room can be used at any point of the day depending on the child's needs.
